1. What is the Tarp Tow® system?

The Tarp Tow® system is a patent pending device that connects a tarp, plastic, or cloth type sheet directly to your lawn tractor or vehicle for towing your outdoor debris or materials with ease.

The Tarp Tow® system was created because of necessity. I knew if I used a garden trailer most of my lawn debris (such as tree branches) was either too long or the volume of my debris was so great that it would cause too many trips back and forth.

Because of this, I decided not to buy a garden trailer but to just manually pull my debris using a tarp. Over the years, while making many trips back and forth using my tarp, I kept asking myself, “How can I use my lawn tractor to do this because there has to be an easier way?”

This is where my needs and innovation came together and the Tarp Tow® system was born. Once it was created and connected to my lawn tractor for the first time, I realized that this was something special because now I could do all my yard work in less time and without being exhausted at the end of the day. The Tarp Tow® system is not limited by what type or size of tarp, plastic, or cloth type sheet you use, but only by the power of your lawn tractor and the size of your property.

This is why I want to share the Tarp Tow® system with you today because I know this system works and it will make your yard work much easier, as it did for me. The patent pending clamping device allows the use of any type sheet material because the system does not require grommets within the material as a connection point.

2. Why should I buy the Tarp Tow® system and not a garden type trailer?

First of all, I couldn't find any garden type trailers that meet my needs because usually they are not large enough to handle the size of most of my loads and they won't fit in tight places around my yard. (This was why I was dragging a tarp in the first place.)

Secondly, you have to lift everything up about 3 feet just to load a garden trailer. Doing this process over and over will wear you out very fast.

The third issue is the storage of the trailer itself. Most garden trailers have a large foot print, making them hard to store and taking up so much room when not in use.

The Tarp Tow® system can use any length of sheet needed for your work at hand. It is only limited by how much your lawn tractor can tow and the size of your yard. As an example, the Tarp Tow® system pictured in this website is using construction plastic that is 10' x 25' - 6mil. This is one of the things that makes the Tarp Tow® system great because you can make your sheet lengths as long as you need for your debris or material.

The Tarp Tow® system is at ground level so you don't have to lift your debris up to load it. Offloading it is just as simple. Just go to one of the end corners of the sheet and pull it over the top of the debris. This causes the debris to fall off the sheet as it flips over.

No more storage problems because, if you desire, the Tarp Tow® system can easily be left permanently attached to your lawn tractor. It only adds 4 to 5 inches in overall length, so it is very easy to leave on your lawn tractor when not in use. It also can be easily removed if needed. Try doing that with a garden trailer!

3. What do you mean when you say any type of foldable sheet material, such as a tarp, plastic, or cloth sheet can be used within the Tarp Tow® system?

The Tarp Tow® system utilizes a patent pending clamp design that allows the use of any type of foldable type sheet material to be used. The actual clamping point gets tighter the harder you pull on it when towing.

This patent pending clamp does not require grommets in the sheet material as a connection point. By eliminating the use of grommets, you not only increase the towing capacity of the tarp or sheet, but now you can tow using any type of foldable sheet material. This makes the Tarp Tow® system so great because you're not restricted to the type material for towing.

If your bed sheet is strong and long enough, it could even be used. Amazing!!!

4. What do you mean by not using a grommet type connection point within the sheet material?

The majority of tarps sold today have grommets within the material to be used as a way to hold the tarp down or in position by using a cable, rope or bungee cord. Under this type connect point you will find out that under heavy loads or continuous use that the grommets will pull or tear out of the material. The Tarp Tow® System can use any type of foldable sheet material because it does not require grommets within the material as a connection point.

5. How does it connect to my lawn tractor?

The Tarp Tow® system is engineered to have a universal mounting design that easily attaches to the rear receiver hitch of both new and old style lawn tractors. Two stabilizers are directly connected from the Tarp Tow® system to the lawn tractors frame for added support. The Tarp Tow® system comes with all the needed hardware and a step-by-step manual on how to install it onto your lawn tractor. You can always take it to your local lawn mower shop and they can easily attach it for you if don't feel "hands-on" enough.

6. Can I use the Tarp Tow® System with my vehicle or ATV?

The Tarp Tow® System has a soon-to-be-released optional adapter kit that will allow the system to be connected to a standard 2" receiver hitch. Even if you do not own a lawn tractor, this will allow you to use the Tarp Tow® system with all vehicles or ATV's that have a 2" receiver hitch.
